Pupil Premium Information

The Pupil Premium is an allocation of additional funding provided to school to support specific groups of children who are vulnerable to possible underachievement. According to the Department for Education (DfE), this includes pupils who are entitled to free school meals, those looked after by the local authority and the children of armed forces personnel.

All schools are required to report on the amount of funding received and how this is being used. Once information is available, the impact of the funding should also be reported.
