
Curriculum Overview Autumn 1 2020

What we have learnt this half term:

Area of Learning	Reception
Communication and Language	We have used new vocabulary to imagine and recreate roles from Traditional Stories. We have learned to listen to our teachers and our friends when they are speaking and we know they will listen to us when it is our turn.
Physical	We have learned to dress and undress ourselves ready for PE. We have enjoyed some simple gymnastics and REAL PE. We have learned to use tools such as pencils and scissors effectively.
Personal, Social and Emotional	We have learned that we are very special people and made a lot of new friends. We now know the people in school and know they will help us.
Literacy	We have started Phase 2 of Letters and Sounds. We have learnt how to listen for rhyme in our Nursery Rhymes and enjoyed the characters. We have also listened to Traditional Stories and joined in telling the story.
Maths	We have learned all about a place called Ten Town. We have found out about the number characters that live there and have learned to write the number.
Understanding the World	We have learned about Autumn and Harvest. We have explored science activities linked to Nursery Rhymes and have made gingerbread men and porridge.
Expressive Arts and Design	We have drawn and painted pictures of ourselves and our favourite things. For our Autumn display we learned how to choose a particular colour and make a collage.
